## **Anne K. Ream**

Anne Ream is a Chicago-based writer and the founder of The Voices and Faces Project, a national documentary initiative created to bring the testimony of sexual violence survivors to the attention of the public. A longstanding advocate for women's issues, Anne is also the Co-Founder and Chief Creative Officer for [Girl360.net](http://Girl360.net), an empowerment project for tween girls, and the executive producer of [The Voices and Faces Project, Volume One](#), a benefit cd that features many of today's hottest indie-rock artists. A former Senior Vice President



and Group Creative Director at Leo Burnett USA, one of the country's largest communications agencies, Anne believes that creative and media-driven ideas can play an important role in social movements.

## **John Shadegg - United States Congressman, 3rd District, Arizona**

John Shadegg was elected to Congress as part of the Republican Revolution in 1994 and has continued to hold fast to the principles of freedom and limited government. He served as Chairman of the House Republican Policy Committee and is a founding member of the Republican Study Committee. Congressman Shadegg is known for his strong advocacy for free market health care reform and energy policy designed to reduce our dependence on foreign sources. He is the original sponsor of H.R. 731, "Jenny's Law", which would deny funeral honors and burial in military cemeteries to veterans convicted of the most violent sex crimes, those classified as Tier III under the National Sex Offender Registry."

## **Bonnie Dumanis - San Diego County District Attorney**

District Attorney Bonnie Dumanis has earned a national reputation as a law enforcement leader and innovator. She took office in 2003 and is the first woman to serve as District Attorney for San Diego County. Under her direction, the office helped write and pass Jessica's Law, which tightened restrictions on child molesters and sexually-violent predators. Her office is also leading California in implementing a prisoner reform program, which provides non-violent offenders with job training, treatment, and wrap around services to keep them from returning to a life of crime once they are released from prison.

Bonnie Dumanis began her legal career as clerk-typist in the DA's Office, working her way up to becoming a hard-hitting prosecutor and eventually a Superior Court Judge. Even though she is the top law enforcement official in San Diego County, Bonnie has never forgotten her roots. A plaque in her office reads, "*The clerk helping in your division today, may be your boss tomorrow.*"

## **Carol Lebeau**

Born in Davenport, Iowa, Carol Lebeau never thought that she would have celebrated 28 years at San Diego's Channel 10, KGTV.....but that's exactly what she did. During her tenure at KGTV, she toured with the Pope, jogged with the President and interviewed Oprah. Carol has the distinction, along with colleague Kimberly Hunt, of being part of the longest-running female news anchor team in the country. These days, Carol divides her time between freelance health reporting and advocacy to motivational speaking for women and faith-based groups.
